Our journeys are led by experienced local expert guides who bring Ethiopia’s stories to life with knowledge and heart.



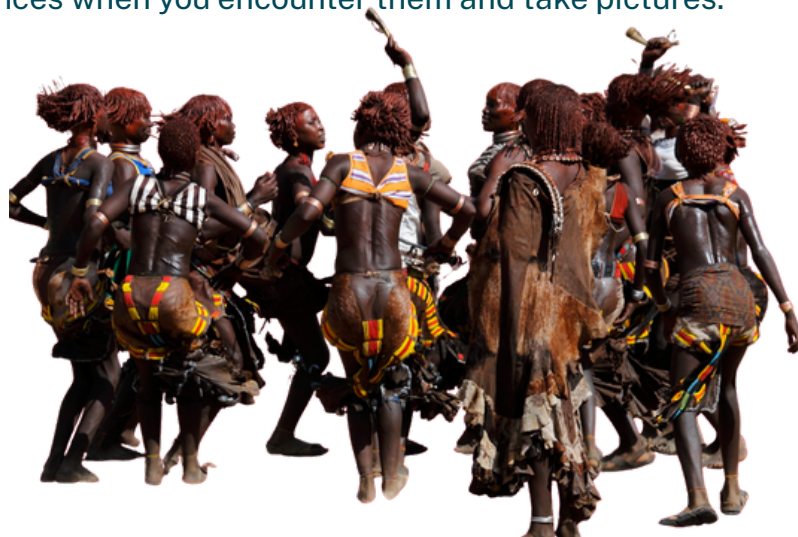

DAY 1 | ARRIVAL

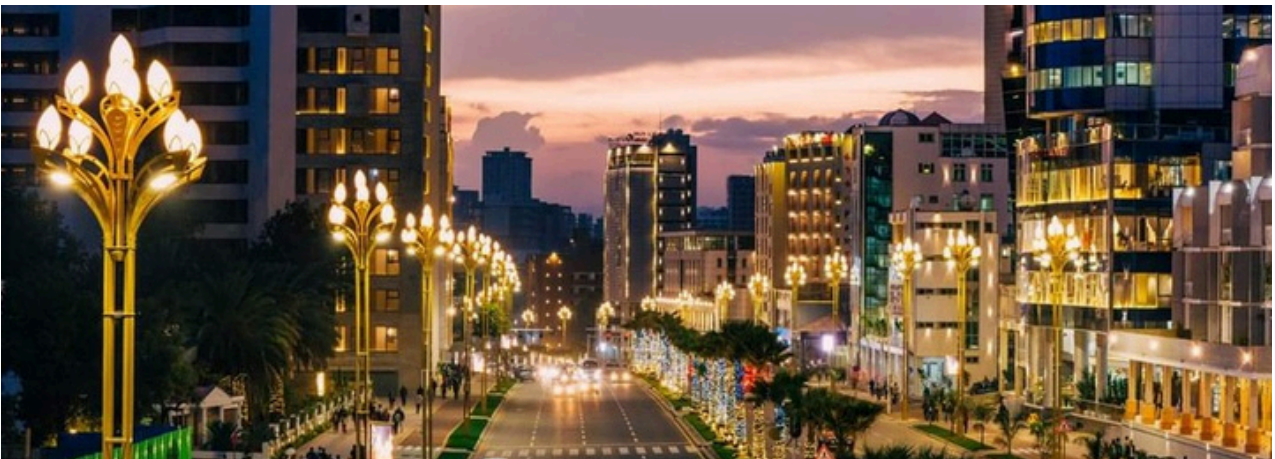
Welcome to Addis Ababa, the world's fourth-highest capital city, whose name beautifully translates to "New Flower."



On arrival, you will be received with warm Ethiopian hospitality by our VIP meet-and-greet team. After assistance through immigration, you will be escorted to the terminal parking area where your driver awaits for a comfortable transfer to your hotel. Following check-in, the remainder of the day is at leisure, an opportunity to relax, settle in, and gently acclimate to the pace and atmosphere of Ethiopia.

DAY 2 | EXPLORE ADDIS

Addis Ababa, the hub of Africa



Sit on a chair above a small fire of twigs made from traditional beauty remedies.



Today, we will head up to Entoto Mountain Park where we'll have a unique panoramic view point of the city. In the park, we'll find Kategna Restaurant where we'll have an authentic Ethiopian lunch paired with a delightful injera baking experience, allowing us to create our own injera while hearing stories and understanding the culture behind the Ethiopian cuisine.

Then, let us continue the refreshing treatment at Weyba Tis Spa, a special tradition of ancestral healing where the name "Weyba Tis" translates to Sacred Water. Weyba Tis Spa is an Ethiopian traditional steam ritual infused with aromatic herbs, followed by rejuvenating treatments that harmonize the body, and relaxes muscle tension.



Addis is lit with the beautiful night lights across the city, and this evening we will have a lively welcome dinner at an elegant venue with our professional guide, celebrating the beginning of an immersive and meaningful adventure with Leswa Ethiopia Tour.

Weyba Tis is a sauna-like traditional Ethiopian beauty therapy.

DAY 3: FLY ADDIS TO JINKA

Nothing prepares you for the extraordinary cultural integrity of the South Omo inhabitants.



We fly south this morning into the administrative capital of South Omo Zone, Jinka, and drive overland to settle into our nature-inspired lodge. We will start our activity with an afternoon visit of South Omo Research Center built on a hill overlooking the north end of the town center. The museum provides a useful insight of 16 different cultural groups associated with the South Omo region. Afterwards, we will have a gentle evening of cultural storytelling shared with local women; a beautiful exchange of voices and experiences.

The Ari Tribe in Jinka are one of the most numerous ethnolinguistic group of South Omo and are well known for producing excellent honey and agriculture.

Most Ari people in Jinka now wear western clothes, but rural area still wear a dress made with leave (Enset and Koicha) and decorate with arm and waist beads.

DAY 4 | DRIVE JINKA TO TURMI AND VISIT KEY AFER MARKET AND MURSI TRIBE



After spending the night in Jinka, we will start our journey to Turmi.

Key Afer is an important stop on the way to Turmi and is known for its vibrant weekly market, which brings together several ethnic groups from the surrounding Omo Valley region. In recent years, some members of the Mursi Tribe—who traditionally lived deeper inside Mago National Park near Jinka—have relocated closer to the Key Afer area. Because of this, visitors can now meet and interact with Mursi people around Key Afer without traveling far into the park. This offers guests the opportunity to learn about the Mursi culture, including their distinctive traditions such as the clay lip plates worn by women.



Continue the journey toward Turmi.

DAY 5 | HAMMER & KARO

South Omo can feel like a journey through time, arriving at something as close as there is to an Africa untouched by outside influence.



This morning, we will drive up to visit the Karo tribe within Kolcho settlement in Murulle. It's a compact village set on a magnificent sand cliff overlooking the Omo River. The Karo are best known for their elaborate body painting, and you can take part in the activity.



Later in the afternoon we will visit the most identifiable group of the South Omo People with elaborate costumes of beads, thick copper necklaces and high cheekbones. The Hammer women are particularly striking, with thick plaits of ochre-colored hair hanging down in a heavy fringe and thick goat skin attire that hang as an apron-like form from the neck down. In the community, we will attend the Evangadi dance ceremony and learn the symbolism behind their art. Afterwards, we will return back to our lodge, and spend the evening bonding over the experience.

DAY 6 | DASSANECH TRIBE/DIMEKA MARKET

South Omo can feel like a journey through time, arriving at something as close as there is to an Africa untouched by outside influence.



Today, continue the cultural exploration of the Omo Valley with a visit to the Dassanech Tribe, who live along the banks of the Omo River near Omorate. To reach the village, visitors usually cross the river by a traditional wooden canoe, offering a unique experience and an opportunity to observe the daily life of the Dassanech people, who are known for their distinctive hairstyles, body ornaments, and pastoral lifestyle.



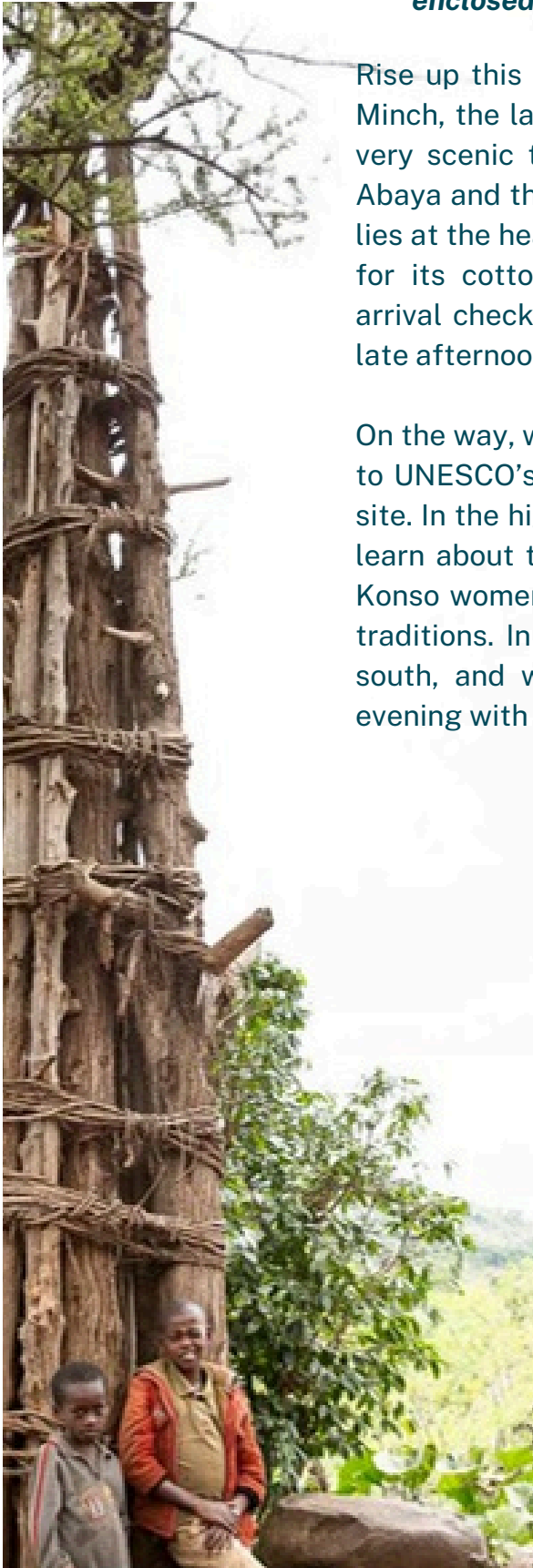
After the village visit, the journey continues back toward Turmi to attend the lively Dimeka Market. This market, typically held on Saturdays, is one of the most important gathering places for the Hamar Tribe and neighboring communities. It is a vibrant cultural scene where locals trade livestock, grains, honey, and handmade items, making it an excellent opportunity for travelers to witness the rich traditions and social interactions of the Omo Valley communities.

DAY 7 | DRIVE TO ARBA MINCH

The most outwardly distinctive feature of Konso is its aesthetically pleasing village enclosed by stone walls.



Rise up this morning and we will travel north to Arba Minch, the largest town in Ethiopia's deep south. It's a very scenic town offering views of lakes Chamo and Abaya and the lush ground water forest. The town also lies at the heart of a bountiful agricultural area, farmed for its cotton, fruit and vegetable production. Upon arrival check into your hotel and enjoy the rest of the late afternoon relaxing by pool and the lakeside breeze.

On the way, we will visit the traditional villages integral to UNESCO's Konso cultural landscape world heritage site. In the highlands we will go into individual villages, learn about the Konso society structure and meet the Konso women artisans known for their cotton weaving traditions. In the late afternoon we'll continue driving south, and we will check-in to our lodge. Enjoy the evening with sunset drinks and nature's peace.

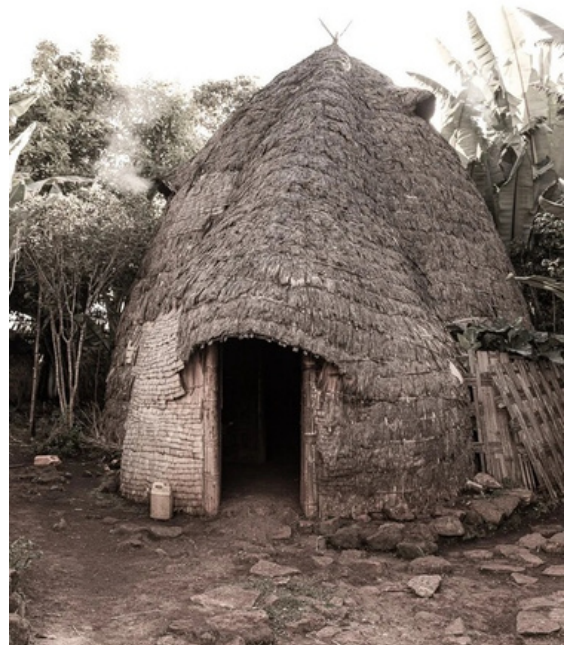


DAY 8 | DORZE VILLAGE EXPERIENCE

Dorze celebrations are very colorful.

Today, you will enjoy a scenic boat trip on Lake Chamo, which is well known for its rich wildlife and stunning landscapes. During the boat excursion, visitors often see large groups of hippos, Nile crocodiles, and a variety of water birds along the shoreline. One of the highlights is the famous “Crocodile Market,” where many crocodiles gather on the banks of the lake. After the boat trip, travelers visit the Forty Springs (locally known as Arba Minch Springs), a lush groundwater forest area that gives the town its name, meaning “forty springs.” Walking through this green forest offers a refreshing experience and the chance to see monkeys and various bird species while learning about the natural springs that flow from the nearby highlands.

In the afternoon, we will visit the colorful Dorze highlands who are known for their towering beehive-shaped homestead and cotton weaving skills. Upon arrival we are guided by talented women into the villages where we will share a traditional Dorze meal and learn about their lifestyle. There will be a traditional Dorze dance and we are invited to join them, making it a fully interactive and unforgettable cultural experience.
